Prohibition of Ragging

- The college shall take strict action against those involved/abetment of ragging in compliance with the provision of the UGC guidelines and State Government Act.

Measures to prohibit ragging at the College level

- The college has taken measures to generate awareness through postering in strategic locations which includes hostel, corridors, common rooms and other entry points.
- ❖ At the commencement of the academic session, the Head of the Institution addresses students regarding rules and regulations for banning ragging and steps to be taken to identify the offenders and punish them accordingly.
- * Students who are allotted hostel admission; are required to provide the names of local guardians.
