

## Brief description of programmes held during 2021-2022 academic session by

## NSS Unit-I & Unit- II Hooghly Women's College



NSS Unit-I & Unit-II have organized a One Day Awareness programme on 02/12/2021 from 11:00 am onwards at college hall, in association with Chandannagore Police Commissionerate for students and other stake holders of the college. The Programme was titled as "Crime and Society". The basic aim of this one day programme was to raise awareness about the nature of crime/cyber crime in our society and how to prevent crime so that we can make our society a better living space. Commissioner of Police, Chandannagore Police Commissionerate delivered the keynote lecture, which was highly beneficial for the students. Asit Majumdar, MLA, Chinsurah, was present as hon'ble chief guest and motivated our students. Almost 96 students and 20 faculty members and office staff attended the programme on that day.













International Mother Language Day (আন্তর্জাতিক মাতৃভাষা দিবস/ ভাষা শহীদ দিবস) was celebrated by NSS Unit-I & Unit-II on 21/02/2022, at college campus. The programme was inaugurated by Dr. Sima Banerjee, our respected Principal. Dr. Nirmalya Sensharma, Associated Professor, Department of Bengali, delivered the keynote lecture about the background and importance of this day. A special book named "Anirban", (on our mother language and its impact on our lives and society), composed by him (published by Hooghly Women's College),was unveiled at this event. The day long programme was celebrated through various cultural performances by students and faculty members. Approximately, 90 students and faculty members took part in this programme.











A Literacy Awareness Drive (as a part of community out reach programme) for the girl students (of minority community of our society) was organized by NSS Unit-I & Unit-II, Hooghly Women's College, at Bandel Mission School, Bhatua, Rajhat, Bandel, on 08/04/2022. Students of Bandel Mission School, have participated at this drive. NSS programme officers of NSS Unit-I & II, Chirantan Hazra & Dr. Sologna Modak explained the motto and outcome of this drive to the students and interacted with them. Some text books, reference books (of class IX, X, XI,XII standard) were donated to the library of Bandel Mission School and handed over to the Students.









NSS Unit-I & Unit-II, Hooghly Women's College arranged a Literacy Awareness Rally at the nearby slum area at Jugudaspara, Hooghly on 08/04/2023 to spread awareness about Child Education (among economically weaker section of our society) as the part of community out reach programme. The rally, led by our NSS vlounteers and NSS programme officers reached at the slum area where children of age group 4-12 (of the slum area) attended the programme. Student volunteers interacted with those children and their parents, thus tried to motivate them about need of child education. School stationary kits (exercise copy, pen, pencil, colour pencils etc.) were distributed among 72 children of that slum area.
